Notification

It has been observed that the Performance of students in HSLC/AHM Examination is not upto the mark. There are several reasons for the same out of which the following are considered to be important.

- (a) No detention system.
- (b) Improper evaluation of students in mid term examination.
- (c) Lack of knowledge amongst the parents about performance of the student
- (d) Remedial/Coaching by teachers.


To address all the above issues Board of Secondary Education, Assam has received suggestions from **Byaktigata Bidyalay Samannay Mancha**, which was communicated to all Heads of Institutions through Inspector of Schools for wide circulations vide this office letter No. SEBA/AB/Syll/33/2004 Dtd. 22nd August, 2017 and to offer their views on suggestions.

SEBA has received opinions of Inspector of Schools and after discussions SEBA has decided to take the following steps to improve the performance of each student appearing in the HSLC/AHM Examinations 2018 onwards.

- Step No. 1:** All the head of Institution will hold a Pre-test Examinations of all the students who are likely to appear in HSLC/AHM Examinations, 2018, in between **1st October to 10th October, 2017**. The evaluation result of the pre-test has to be shared with parents of the student including providing of answer-scripts to the parents.
- Step No. 2:** The Head of the Institutions will have to obtain a written undertaking stating that he will supervise the study of his ward from the parents of the student whose performance are found low. The parent has to be apprised of the performance of their wards personally by the teachers of each subjects.
- Step No. 3:** The submission date for the forms for HSLC/AHM Examination, 2018 will start from **6/11/2017**. All the candidates including the low performed students will have to fill the forms for examination, without any discrimination.
- Step No. 4:** All the Heads of the Institutions will have to hold again the Preparatory Examination of Class X from **7th December, 2017** onwards and the results of the Preparatory Examination must be completed before **30th December, 2017**.
- Step No. 5:** The results of Low performed students in the Preparatory Examination has to be examined by all the teachers of concerned subject and they have to give remedial coaching to all these students from **1st January to the date of examination of HSLC, 2018** to improve their performance.

The above entire exercise will help in building a direct relation with all the parents of students with the teacher and it will help in improvement of performance of students. This is applicable for all categories of schools, including private etc.

It is therefore requested to all Inspector of Schools/Head of Institutions/teachers of all educational institutions to adhere to the above instructions properly.
